

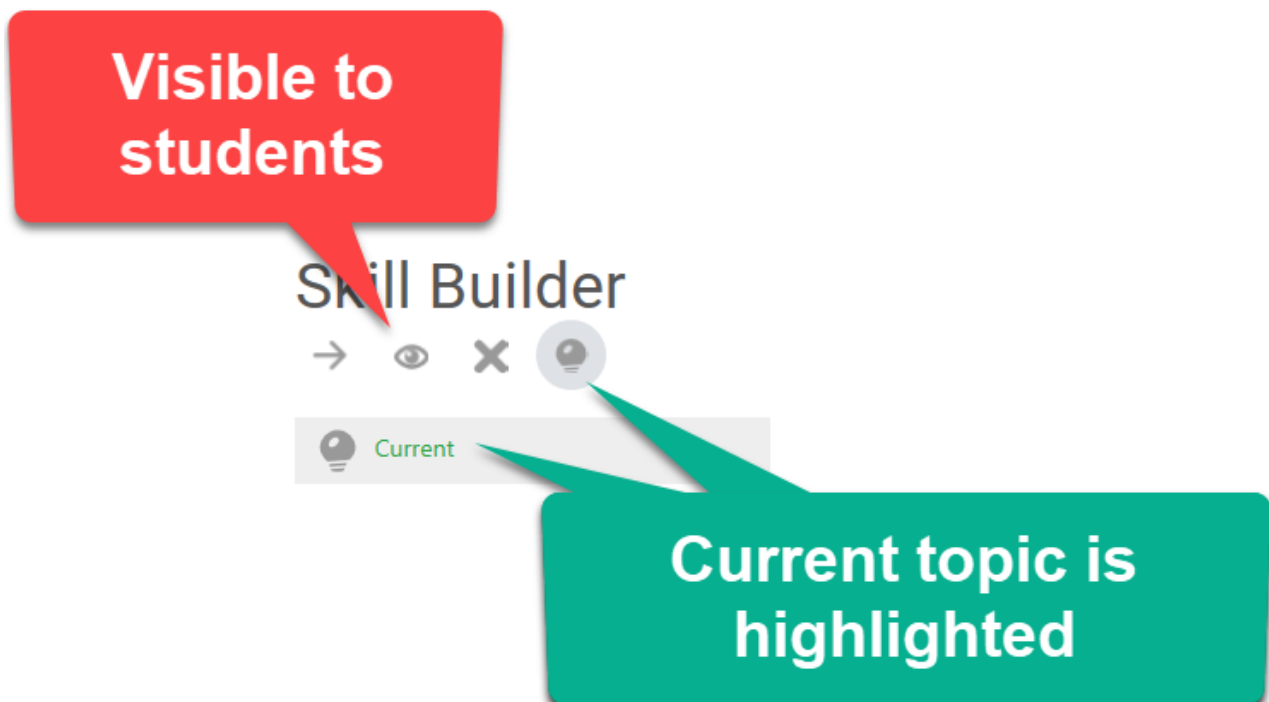
Make activities visible and highlight the current topic

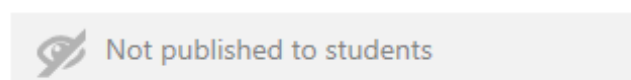

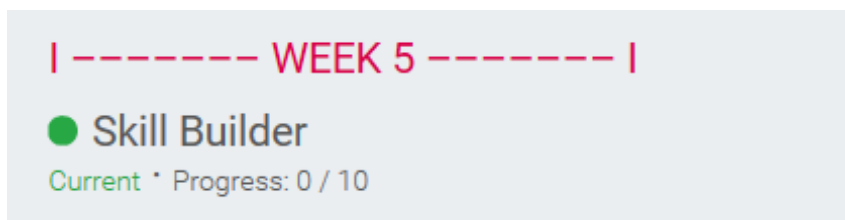

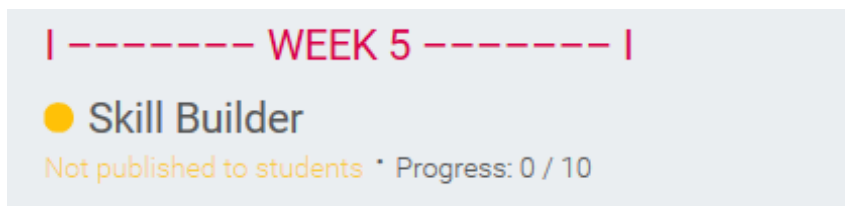
