

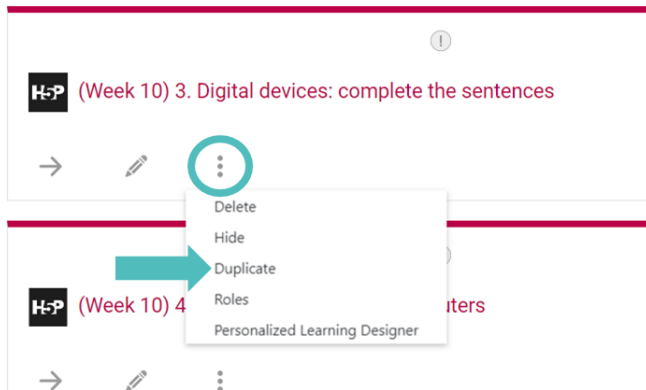
# Duplicating and moving activities

## DUPLICATING AN ACTIVITY

### Step One

Click the "Menu" (ellipsis) icon and select "Duplicate"

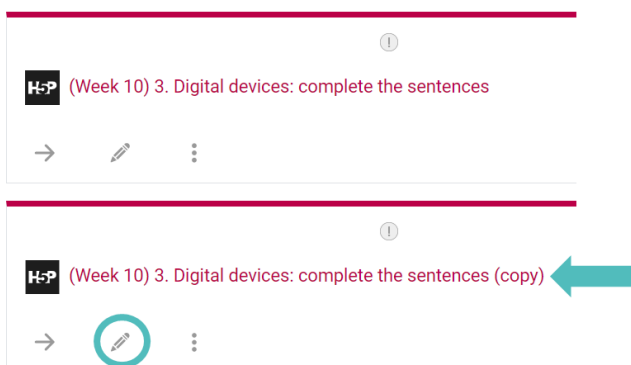


### Step Two

The duplicated activity will be displayed under the original activity. The title will include "(copy)".

To edit the title click on the "Edit" (pencil) icon.

NOTE: Opening a H5P to edit can be slow and seem like it is not working, please be patient.



### Step Three

Replace or edit the text in the "Title" text box.

NOTE: This may look slightly different in different activity types, however it will always be towards the top of the activity and be labelled "Title".

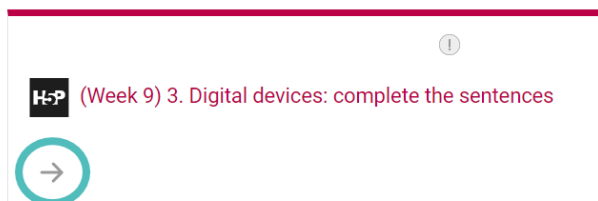

### Step Two - moving within the same week

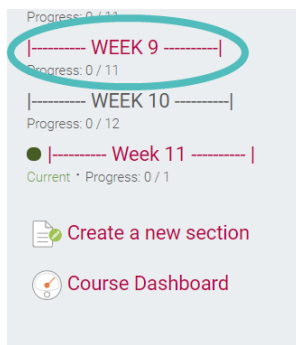
To move an activity to another location with in the same week, scroll to place you want to put it and click "Move here"
